How does it work?

1 SIGN UP

Submit your application by filling out the form on **www.buddy.unhcr.it**. You will be contacted by one of our representatives to discuss your expectations and reasons.

2 TRAINING

You will be invited to participate in a training course in order to better understand how the project works.

3 MATCHING

By comparing your personal characteristics with those of a volunteer or a refugee registered with the project, we will match you with a person who will feel comfortable with you. We will check your compatibility together.

4 MEETING

The project, lasting a minimum of six months, will then start. During this period, you both can start to meet up and get to know each other in a way that suits your needs. We will be by your side for the entire process.
